BACHELOR'S DEGREE IN BIBLICAL COUNSELING

Course Descriptions – Year 2





CNR 301 Counseling Resources in Literature II

3 credits

This course examines Biblical truths and applications in the areas of marriage, parenting, and suffering. You also explore spiritual disciplines to grow closer to God.



BIB 301 New Testament – The Gospels, Acts and Epistles

3 credits

As we study the bible and grow in our knowledge of God, believers can discover who God made them to be, what they are now, and what they are becoming. The chapters, questions, and answers are chosen to help the student consider closely and discern well the difference between cultural, humanistic, and biblical counsel. This course specifically covers 12 books, Matthew – Colossians.



BCE 301 Marriage Counseling Essentials

2 credits

This course provides essential tools for counseling specific issues in marriagepornography, effects of premarital sex, resolving conflict, making important decisions together, role reversals, effective communication, etc.



CNI 301 Counseling Relationship Issues

3 credits

This course addresses relational issues that may arise in the areas of both marriage and parenting – adultery, divorce, sexual integrity, dysfunctional families, blended families, etc.



SALT 301 Marital Area of Life Essentials

3 credits

In this class you learn how to become more intimate with your spouse - physically, psychologically, and spiritually. Communication roles in marriage and how to restore intimacy are discussed.



IPC 301 Individual Personal Counseling - Marital

2 credits

During this course you are personally counseled by your Faculty Trainer in the Marital Area of Life. Examine ways to become more intimate with your spouse and with the Lord.



SALT 302 Parental Area of Life Essentials

3 credits

This class teaches parenting styles and gives you tools for how to be a parent who helps their child become a mature adult.



IPC 302 Individual Personal Counseling – Parental

2 credits

During this course you are personally counseled by your Faculty Trainer in the Parental Area of Life. Examine the effects of how you were raised, and the parenting styles that you and your spouse use with your own children.



PPC 401 Peer Partner Counseling – Marital

2 credits

In this class you will practice counseling a student peer partner in the Marital area of life. A Faculty Trainer will supervise these sessions live and provide you helpful, instructive, and encouraging feedback.



PPC 402 Peer Partner Counseling – Parental

2 credits

In this class you will practice counseling a student peer partner in the Parental area of life. A Faculty Trainer will supervise these sessions live and provide you helpful, instructive, and encouraging feedback.



CNI 302 Counseling Presenting Issues

3 credits

A myriad of issues are brought up in a counseling session and this class is designed to equip you with a biblical approach to help your clients experience healing and victory. Topics include eating disorders, self-harm, cutting, substance abuse, suicide, dealing with the demonic, and others.



BCE 302 Parenting Counseling Essentials

2 credits

This course provides essential tools for counseling specific issues in parenting-true identity, self-worth, crushed spirit, preparation for independence, etc.



BIB 401 New Testament – Epistles, Letters and Revelation 3 credits

This course concludes our study of the New Testament with a look at the last 15 books finishing up with Paul's Epistles, General Letters and the final book of the Bible called Revelation.



CNI 401 Counseling Life Issues

3 credits

In this course you will gain a deeper understanding of how the truths explained in the Seven Areas of Life (SALT) teachings can be applied to all areas of life and utilized during a counseling session.



PMC 301 Premarital Counseling Tools

3 credits

In this course you learn three different levels of intimacy that are important to discuss in counseling engaged couples. You also learn what root issues are common that cause conflict before and after the wedding day.



PDC 301 Parents Discipling Children

3 credits

This course shows you the significance of discipling children in all seven areas of life include a webinar from the authors explaining the *I Want to Teach You What I Believe* book.



BCP 410 Biblical Counseling Practicum I

6 credits

In this class you will counsel outside clients using the skills and tools you've received during your program. A Faculty Trainer will listen to recordings of these sessions and provide helpful, instructive, and encouraging feedback.



BCP 420 Biblical Counseling Practicum II

6 credits

In this class you will counsel outside clients using the skills and tools you've received during your program. A Faculty Trainer will listen to recordings of these sessions and provide helpful, instructive, and encouraging feedback.



BCP 430 Biblical Counseling Practicum III

6 credits
